Did you know when we make the sign of the cross we are doing much more than a "Catholic thing?" Making the sign of the cross may be a common action which we Catholics do, but do you know why and what it means? This ancient gestural prayer customarily begins and ends our formal prayer; from grace before meals to

the Mass. According to the Catholic Encyclopedia, the ancient origin of the Sign of the Cross is unclear, but its form has evolved over time.

In the Sign of the Cross, we are saying we believe in God, a Trinity of three persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and the redemption of the cross. The combination of the words and action are a creed, a statement of belief. We mark ourselves as Christians through the Sign of the Cross, reminding ourselves the purpose of the cross, and remembering the price that was paid for our salvation. The use of holy water when making the sign of the cross, as we do when we enter a church, also recalls our Baptism which should bring to mind, we are born again of water and Spirit.

The sign of the cross indicates the very Cross of our salvation. Our most common gesture, the sign of the cross, is really the signature of our Catholic faith.

**Spiritual Work of Mercy** – It is a Spiritual Work of Mercy to pray for the deceased. The death toll now in the United States is 122,000+ and world-wide death toll is now at 472,000+ due to Covid-19. Many of these persons have been buried without the customary religious services, and some have no one to pray for the repose of their souls. While we continue to pray for an end to the pandemic & all those who have been affected, in charity, let us not forget to assist the faithful departed with our prayers & Masses.
