Christmas Masses – Due to the diocesan and governmental restrictions on capacity, we can only seat about 400 people in the building per Mass time. Therefore, we will be using a reservation system for our six Christmas Masses. Our Mass times are: Christmas Eve, 4:00pm, 6:00pm, and 8:00pm, all in English; Christmas Day, 8:00am and 10:00am both in English followed by 11:45am in Spanish. You will need a reservation for a seat in the building, it is not a guarantee for a seat in the main worship space in the Church. Seating will begin 45 minutes prior to Mass and will be done on a "first-come-first-choice" basis, like any normal Mass. Reservations will become invalid 15 minutes before the start of Mass. Reservations are limited to 10 seats per family; if you need more than 10 seats, please email Elizabeth. Reservations will be available until December 15th unless we reach our Mass capacity sooner. We continue to thank you for your patience and support during this time. Please know that you have additional options for Mass should you choose to attend, such as utilizing overflow seating available in the family life center, chapel, and narthex; or, participating in the Mass via YouTube in your car, or listening over the speakers in the courtyard, & coming inside for Holy Communion only.



Work will be starting soon on the ministry schedule for the months of January, February and March. Please note that January 1 was included in last quarter's schedule. This schedule will include

special Masses for Ash Wednesday (February 17). If you do not indicate a preferred Mass time for Holy Days, please note that you may be scheduled at a time you do not normally attend Mass on those special days. <u>A friendly reminder that the</u> *parish office does not find subs*.

Plenary Indulgence – Many of the Church's pastors have requested an adaptation to the requirements to obtain the Plenary Indulgence for the deceased in the month of November. Thus, "by the special mandate of His Holiness Pope Francis", the Apostolic Penitentiary released on Friday, these modifications.

- ★ During month of November Due to the coronavirus pandemic and the need to avoid large groups from forming where prohibited, the Plenary Indulgence applicable to the deceased by those who visit a cemetery has been extended beyond the normal dates of 1 to 8 November. This year, the Indulgence can be obtained by anyone who visits a cemetery, even if only mentally, on any day in November, & devoutly prays for the faithful departed.
- ★ Homebound Anyone who cannot leave their home for various reasons, including anti-COVID restrictions, they too can obtain the Plenary Indulgence by "uniting themselves spiritually to other members of the faithful". In this case, the condition being "completely detached from sin" and the intention of completing the other requirements for obtaining a Plenary Indulgence. These conditions are Confession, reception of Holy Communion and prayer for the Holy Father's intentions.

The Decree suggests that such prayer take place before an "image of Jesus or the Blessed Virgin Mary". Among the various prayers recommended are "prayers for the deceased, Morning or Evening Prayer from the Office of the Dead, the Rosary, Divine Mercy Chaplet, meditating on various Gospel passages proposed for the liturgy of the Dead, or completing a work of mercy by offering to God the suffering & discomforts of one's own life." Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament - Due to covid-19, Eucharistic Adoration has moved to the St. Francis of Assisi Chapel and is available Mon. – Thur. 9:00 – 11:50am and 1:00 - 3:00pm and Friday 9:00 - 11:50am. Jesus said: "Come to Me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest." Are you tired because of the burden of your duties, because of frustration due to unsuccessful projects, because many misunderstand you? Are you heavy laden with guilt from past sins? Are you trying to find hope and meaning in life? Do not lose your heart! Abandon yourself to Jesus in this "Sacrament of Love" He will refresh you! Those who are devoted to the Eucharistic Adoration program witness a happier and more content life knowing that the Lord is with them always. For every hour we give Him, He showers us with many gifts including peace and mind and heart. The Guardian Angels of the Blessed Sacrament ministry needs adorers who would like to commit One Hour every week.
