Our weekday Mass schedule will be the same this week with the exception of Thanksgiving Day. Join us for Mass on the morning of Thanksgiving at 10:00am in the church.

RCIA Calendar – There will be NO class Wednesday, November 25, due to the Thanksgiving holiday. The next session will be Wednesday, December 2, on the Commandments 1-10 led by Msgr. Marczuk. RCIA meets in the Church. We meet every Wednesday at 7:00pm.

Sunday Missals – We now have the Sunday Missals for Liturgical Year B available for \$5. Look for them on the window ledge outside the receptionist office.

Christmas Masses – Due to the diocesan and governmental restrictions on capacity, we can only seat about 400 people in the building per Mass time. Therefore, we will be using a reservation system for our six Christmas Masses. Our Mass times are: Christmas Eve, 4:00pm*, 6:00pm, and 8:00pm, all in English; Christmas Day, 8:00am and 10:00am both in English followed by 11:45am in Spanish. You will need a reservation for a seat in the building, it is not a guarantee for a seat in the main worship space in the Church. Seating will begin 45 minutes prior to Mass and will be done on a "first-come-first-choice" basis, like any normal Mass. Reservations will become invalid 15 minutes before the start of Mass. Reservations are limited to 10 seats per family; if you need more than 10 seats, please email Elizabeth. Reservations will be available until December 15th unless we reach our Mass capacity sooner. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament - Due to covid-19, Eucharistic Adoration has moved to the St. Francis of Assisi Chapel and is available Mon. - Thur. 9:00 -11:50am and 1:00 – 3:00pm and Friday 9:00 – 11:50am. Jesus said: "Come to Me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest." Are you tired because of the burden of your duties, because of frustration due to unsuccessful projects, because many misunderstand you? Are you heavy laden with guilt from past sins? Are you trying to find hope and meaning in life? Do not lose your heart! Abandon yourself to Jesus in this "Sacrament of Love" He will refresh you! Those who are devoted to the Eucharistic Adoration program witness a happier and more content life knowing that the Lord is with them always. For every hour we give Him, He showers us with many gifts including peace and mind and heart. The Guardian Angels of the Blessed Sacrament ministry needs adorers who would like to commit One Hour every week. Our goal is to have a permanent and continuing Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament during this time of difficulties. If you are interest please call parish office to schedule a training.

Plenary Indulgence – Many of the Church's pastors have requested an adaptation to the requirements to obtain the Plenary Indulgence for the deceased in the month of November. Thus, "by special mandate of His Holiness Pope Francis", the Apostolic Penitentiary released these modifications.

- ★ During month of November Due to the coronavirus pandemic and the need to avoid large groups from forming where prohibited, the Plenary Indulgence applicable to the deceased by those who visit a cemetery has been extended beyond the normal dates of 1 to 8 November. This year, the Indulgence can be obtained by anyone who visits a cemetery, even if only mentally, on any day in November, and devoutly prays for the faithful departed.
- ★ Homebound Anyone who cannot leave their home for various reasons, including anti-COVID restrictions, they too can obtain the Plenary Indulgence by "uniting themselves spiritually to other members of the faithful." In this case, the condition being "completely detached from sin" and the intention of completing the other requirements for obtaining a Plenary Indulgence. These conditions are Confession, reception of Holy Communion and prayer for the Holy Father's intentions.

The Decree suggests that such prayer take place before an "image of Jesus or the Blessed Virgin Mary." Among the various prayers recommended are "prayers for the deceased, Morning or Evening Prayer from the Office of the Dead, the Rosary, Divine Mercy Chaplet, meditating on various Gospel passages proposed for the liturgy of the Dead, or completing a work of mercy by offering to God the suffering and discomforts of one's own life."



Your Knights of Columbus will restart the gift card program during this Christmas season. Gift cards make a great gift, and with the pandemic, many of our parishioners are trying to stay safe during

the holiday shopping season. If you recall from 2017-2018, when you buy a gift card, the Knights received 1-8% of the card value that was put back into the church and community. 
