Christmas Masses – Due to the diocesan and governmental restrictions on capacity, we can only seat about 400 people in the building per Mass time. Therefore, we will be using a reservation system for our six Christmas Masses. Our Mass times are: Christmas Eve, 4:00pm*, 6:00pm, and 8:00pm, all in English; Christmas Day, 8:00am and 10:00am both in English followed by 11:45am in Spanish. You will need a reservation for a seat in the building, it is not a guarantee for a seat in the main worship space in the Church. Seating will begin 45 minutes prior to Mass and will be done on a "first-come-first-choice" basis, like any normal Mass. Reservations will become invalid 15 minutes before the start of Mass. Reservations are limited to 10 seats per family; if you need more than 10 seats, please email Elizabeth. Reservations will be available until December 15th unless we reach our Mass capacity sooner. Life Teen News – Life Teen has been meeting in person on Sunday and Wednesday evenings since September for youth group and Bible study. We have also offered a virtual component that interacts with our live ministry in real time via Zoom. Turnout has been tremendous this year, and we are grateful that you entrust us with the faith formation of your child as well as their safety. We have introduced several policies in response to COVID-19 including capping capacity, increased sanitization and cleaning procedures, mask requirements, and spaced seating. We are also following the local school districts in regard to meeting in person. If local schools switch to a virtual learning environment, Life Teen will also switch to virtual youth group. Due to Thanksgiving break, Life Teen is not scheduled to meet, but we would have switch to virtual if meetings had been scheduled. We plan to resume IN PERSON ministry on December 6th if the schools return to in person education. It is our hope that our teens will still join us via Zoom on Sunday and Wednesday evenings in the event of continued virtual requirements.
