Safe Haven Baby Box – Springdale has agreed to have a Safe Haven Baby Box! It was a unanimous decision! Mayor Doug Sprouse, Councilman Colby Fulfer and all the Springdale City council voted for the installation of a "baby box" in one of their fire stations. And if that's not enough, NWA Respect Life recently learned that the city of Rogers will also participate in this life saving effort!

The Arkansas Safe Haven law has existed for almost 20 years with similar laws in all 50 states. We've all heard the tragic stories of babies abandoned in dumpsters, creek beds and shopping carts. The Safe Haven law allows a parent to bring a child, 30 days old or younger to an employee at any hospital emergency room or law enforcement agency without facing prosecution for endangering or abandoning a child. In 2019, AR amended the law to include fire departments or a designated newborn safety device (a baby box). The baby box provides an anonymous surrender as well as brings more attention to the existence of the law.




Expenses Month-to-Date - \$ 95,281.14 Loan Balance - \$ 1,279,241.29
