

Fostering Faith Through Creative Work; Inspiring Creative Work Through Faith: Are you interested in how faith and art intersect? Please join us for a Speaker Series night on Sacred Art, on March 1, from 6:30-8:30pm in the Parish Life Center. St. Stephen parishioner, Amy Lane, will use portions of an online lecture on the Book of Kells to springboard into a discussion of how we can use sacred art more consciously in public/private worship and in evangelization. Those attending will also be discussing an opportunity to start a monthly gathering of people from St. Stephen and the surrounding parishes who are interested in fostering and participating in all sorts of creative work for the purpose of worship and outreach.

Speaker Series: Dr. Mark Zia, Professor of Sacred Theology at Benedictine College in Atchison, KS. will present *"The Shroud of Turin"* Sunday, March 5th at 1:30pm at Parish Life Center. He will have life size replicas of the shroud. The talk is free but there will be a free will offering at the end to help cover his costs of speaking.

Fasting and Abstinence during Lent: Practicing as the Church instructs is a good beginning. A bodily way to remind ourselves that we need God above all things, fasting is also a sacrifice, a gift back to God of our heart's intent to depend more completely on God. The interior free desire to deepen our relationship to God is the essence of a Lenten fast. The following is a question /answer to help you:

Q: What are the rules about fasting and abstinence?

A: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence. The law of fasting allows one full meal and two smaller ones. The law of abstinence prohibits the eating of meat. Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence in the United States.

The obligation of abstinence begins at age 14. The law of fasting obliges all between the ages of 18-59.



El Ayuno y la Abstinencia durante la Cuaresma: Practicar como lo instruye la Iglesia es un buen comienzo. Una forma corporal de recordarnos a nosotros mismos que necesitamos a Dios sobre todas las cosas, el ayuno también es un sacrificio, un regalo a Dios de la intención de nuestro corazón de depender más completamente de Dios. El libre deseo interior de profundizar nuestra relación con Dios es la esencia del ayuno de Cuaresma. La siguiente es una pregunta/respuesta para ayudarle:

P: ¿Cuáles son las reglas sobre el ayuno y la abstinencia?

R: El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son días de ayuno y abstinencia. La ley del ayuno permite una comida completa y dos más pequeñas. La ley de abstinencia prohíbe comer carne. Los viernes de Cuaresma son días de abstinencia en los Estados Unidos. La obligación de abstinencia comienza a los 14 años. La ley del ayuno obliga a todos entre los 18 y los 59 años.

Fasting and Feasting Prayer (Excerpt)

Fast from judging others; feast on Christ within in them.

Fast from emphasis on difference; feast on our bonds.

Fast from fear of illness; feast on the healing power of God.

Fast from apparent darkness; feast on God's light.

Fast from words that cut down; feast on speech that uplifts.

Fast from gossip; feast on affirmations.

Fast from discontent; feast on gratitude.

Fast from pessimism; Feast on hope.

Fast from anger; feast on patience.

Fast from negatives; feast on encouragement.

Fast from resentment; feast on forgiveness.

Fast from suspicion; feast on truth.

Fast from self-centeredness; feast on compassion.

First Sunday of Lent Year A: The first reading recounts the story of how Adam and Eve turned away from God. The psalm is a repentant appeal to the goodness of God. The second reading reminds us that even though we are sinners, we are saved through the obedience of Jesus Christ. 
