



St. Stephen Catholic Church Financial Update: Our Parish's financial year began July 1st. St. Stephen has grown to be the 3rd largest parish in the Diocese of Little Rock. Our 2023-2024 budget calls for *Stewardship* to be \$1,825,000 or \$152,083.33 per month and the *Growth Fund* to be \$175,000 or \$14,583.33 per month.

Please prayerfully consider our Parish's funding needs in your monthly budget. Our growth has required larger financial contributions to provide quality programs, maintain and improve our building and hire/retain quality staff. Projects dedicated to our *Growth Fund* are well underway with some already complete. See the poster in the Narthex for a list of the *Growth Fund* projects. The Finance Council, along with Monsignor, are very conscientious of your giving and the cost of operations.

Thank you for all you have provided St. Stephen to reach this point. Our parish will continue to flourish with your spiritual and financial support.


