




Helping Hands Coordinator Needed: Helping Hands Inc. is a non-profit organization operated as a partnership of over 20 churches throughout Benton County. Established in 1976, Helping Hands has been aiding those in need for 46 years through operation of a thrift store located at 2602 SW D St in Bentonville. Proceeds from the thrift store are used to meet the needs of Benton County residents in times of hardship, meeting its vision of a community where everyone experiences hope, and no one goes to bed hungry or in need of shelter, and where all people are treated with dignity. St. Stephen Catholic Church was a long-time volunteer parish, along with St. Vincent de Paul in Rogers. During the pandemic, many partnership churches were unable serve Helping Hands due to public health safety measures and never returned to a regular volunteer schedule, including St. Stephen's.

We are now seeking a parish member willing to share his or her time and talent to help coordinate a group of volunteers to work a rotation of 2-3 Saturday afternoons per year at Helping Hands, providing support working the cash registers, bagging, stocking, and receiving donations from 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Staffing generally only requires 6-10 parishioners, though no volunteers will be turned away and it's also a great way for families to serve together or for students to earn service hours. John Carney of St. Vincent de Paul Church has kindly offered to introduce and train a member of our parish to help us reestablish this social outreach ministry. Please prayerfully consider this opportunity to serve our parish and our brothers and sisters of need in Benton County. 
ARKANSAS CATHOLIC MEN'S CONFERENCE
