

As all of you know, Planned Parenthood has closed in NWA and has not found a place to reopen. 40 Days for Life has started, now through November 3rd, we are blessed not having to pray in front of an abortion clinic. St. Raphael is the most centralized parish which anyone may come and Pray for Life from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM now to November 3rd.
