

News from Bishop Taylor – He is happy to announce that our anti-COVID protocols have been effective in preventing the spread at Mass. We are not aware of a single case of transmission linked to participation in worship at any Catholic Church in Arkansas or for that matter, not any Catholic Church in the United States where these protocols are in place. Therefore, we are now in a position to Iift the dispensation from the obligation of in-person Sunday Mass attendance for everyone who is in good health and not especially vulnerable or caring for someone who is especially vulnerable effective immediately.
