Divine Mercy Sunday, April 11 – St. Stephen will celebrate the Feast of Mercy at 3:00pm (the Hour of Great Mercy) in the Church. The celebration lasts approximately 45 minutes. It will consist of the acknowledgment of this Feast with reflections about St. Faustina, the Chaplet of the Divine Mercy and the Mercy Stations. All are welcome. The following are five intentions given by Pope John Paul II: For use in recitation of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy to end abortion, to end the Culture of Death, to Build a Civilization of Love.

This special year will last from December 8, 2020 to December 8, 2021. A plenary indulgence is granted to the faithful under the usual conditions which include:

- 1. Your soul being free of attachment to sin on the day of indulgence,
- 2. You offer a prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father on the day of the indulgence,
- 3. You receive Holy Communion on the day of the indulgence, and
- 4. You receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation / Penance within 20 days of the day of indulgence.

And during the year of St. Joseph, the above conditions need to be done in addition to one of the following actions:

- Meditate for at least 30 minutes on the Lord's Prayer, or be a part of a spiritual retreat of at least one day that includes a meditation on St. Joseph.
- Perform an act of corporal or spiritual work of mercy,
- Pray the Holy rosary in families and between engaged couples "to recreate the same atmosphere of intimate communion, love and prayer that was in the Holy Family."
- Through prayer entrust the activities and work of the day to St. Joseph, such that all who are looking for work find it, and such that all have dignified work,
- 5) Recite the Litany of St. Joseph for the persecuted Church and for the relief of all Christians who suffer any form of persecution,
- 6) Recite any legitimately approved prayer or act of piety in honor of St. Joseph, especially on the Feast of St. Joseph, March 19th or May 1st or the feast of the Holy Family, or the 19th of evry month, or on every Wednesday, the day dedicated to St. Joseph.

This year, one plenary indulgence per day may be granted to oneself or for any deceased soul. Remember a plenary indulgence cannot be requested for another living person.
